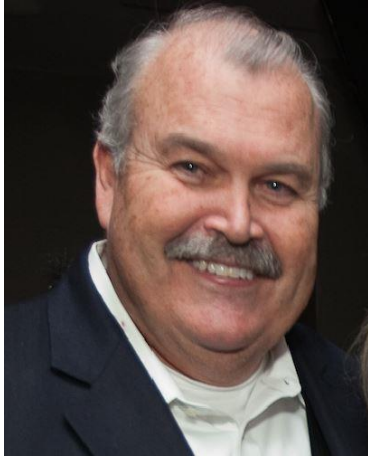




**Daniel Bleemke, Director of Facilities and Engineering

Daniel F. Bleemke works for the Baltimore Museum of Art as Director of Facilities and Engineering.
