THESE COVID-19 GUIDELINES CONFORM TO BALTIMORE COUNTY GUIDELINES

Please Act Responsibly to Protect Yourself and Others

- 1) The caterer will abide by all federal, state, and local executive orders and health regulations pertaining to precautions to prevent the spread of the COVID-19 virus.
- 2) Valley Mansion is abiding by the current Maryland state recovery plan.
 - Capacity restrictions are eliminated for restaurants and bars, however tables must remain 6 feet apart
 - Banquet and Convention facilities may operate at 50% capacity, and tables must remain 6 feet apart
 - Customers must be seated and cannot be standing
 - Face covering rules remain in effect for customers and employees
 - Barriers between booths may now be used instead of keeping every other booth closed
 - For indoor dining, the maximum table size has increased to 10 people. The order does not mention a table capacity limit for outdoor tables.
 - Self-Serve Buffets may reopen – see the Maryland Department of Health Directive for specific requirements
- 3) Masks must be worn indoors at all times.
- 4) All non-seated parties, must wear a face covering when moving in or about the food service areas or at the bar.
- 5) Individuals will not be required to wear a face covering if:
 - Eating or drinking while seated at the table. In accordance with Governor Hogan's orders, face coverings are still required when otherwise moving in or about a restaurant or bar premises.
 - A face covering cannot be worn due to a medical condition, mental health condition or disability. A doctor's note will suffice as evidence of medical condition and will need to be presented.
- 7) Masks and hand sanitizer will be available on site.
